NO DISCHARGE ZONES (NDZ)

The Long Island Sound, Jamaica Bay and the New York waters of the Hudson River from the Battery to Troy Dam are No Discharge Zones, where it is illegal to discharge any boat sewage from a holding tank or portable toilet or use a direct discharge toilet. All sewage must be emptied at a pumpout station. If the waterbody is not a designated No Discharge Zone, boaters may discharge treated sewage from a Type I or Type II USCG certified Marine Sanitation Device (MSD). The practice is discouraged in all near shore waters, near shellfish beds, bathing beaches and areas of high boat concentration.
